Easter Greetings 2018

Go, tell his disciples and Peter that he is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see him, just as he told you. So they went out and fled from the tomb, for terror and amazement had seized them; and they said nothing to any one, for they were afraid. (Mark 16:7,8)

That is the story of Easter.
